Overview:

The Restaurant Menu System allows you to provide “live” specials, as well as, your entire menu directly on your existing restaurant website. **Instantly update your online menu** through a simple, yet powerful, content management system specifically designed for the restaurant industry to market your specials, appetizers, entrees, desserts, drinks, etc.

This menu system was **designed to mirror your printed menus**. After creating your menus and sections, each section can be customized to display those menu items the same way your printed menu does.

There is **no software to install** and the system works with your current website, we do not need to re-design or re-develop your existing website and we do not need to host your restaurant website for you to use this web-based application.

Features:

- Manage Menus (pages) – Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, Wine Lists, etc.
- Manage Menu Sections – Appetizers, Entrees, Desserts, etc.
- Create Menu Items – Titles, Descriptions, Notes and Prices
- Add custom headers and footers to both Menus and Sections
- Customize price column headings – Glass, Pitcher, Bottle, etc.
- Customize each section by selecting from available layouts
- Seasonal items or entire sections can be flagged visible/hidden.
- Seamlessly wrap the menus in your existing website design
- Adjust an item's or entire section's position with one click
- Role-based access controls allows you to grant editor access
- Make changes any time, day or night, with instant updates
- Simple step-by-step online user guide available

This system is a 100% hosted solution. It can be implemented as a php include, a javascript call in html or in a frame or iframe. The system can also source a template file located on your website or create one and host it locally. Which ever implementation is the most seamless and appropriate for your website.
